CONTEST GUIDELINES

- 1. Participation is open to all clubs from all Junior Fair Youth Organizations. Each club is limited to one entry for official judging, however we welcome extra boxes for decoration.
- 2. Flower Box/Planter must be built/ created by club members and must be able to be carried by two people (please keep size reasonable.)
- 3. Flower Box/Planter must be **identified with club name.** Fair theme, and/or club emblem can be incorporated in the design of the flower box. We encourage creativity and originality.
- 4. All flowers **must be natural** (not artificial) . No professionally assisted arrangements will be accepted.
- 5. Club must water & take care of own flower box/planter.
- 6. Flower Box/Planter must be brought to the Event Center by 8:00 p.m. Fair Entry Day. Please register your flower box/planter at the Junior Fair Office in the Event Center.

JUDGES CRITERIA

Flower Box/Planter will be judged in one of the four categories:

1.Original

- 3. Canfield Fair "Memories in the Making"
- 4. Special Category: Support Our Troops Patriotic

They will be judged on the following criteria:

- 1. Creativity and Originality
- 2. Appearance of Total Display
- 3. Floral Organization



AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the Youth Day Program, Thursday, August 31 at 2:00 p.m. There will be 3 placings in each category. First through third place in each category will receive a rosette and a rotating plaque/sign which is to be placed in the planter/flower box.

Club must clearly declare category for judging.
