

# TACK BOX LIST WITH BASIC RULES FOR

## GOATS

Feed-for the week of fair (Individually bagged per day)	Hose
Small Brush—for back pocket while showing	Combs
Soap	Pitch Fork
Bucket for cleaning animal	Rags/towels
Brushes	Collars
Feed Pan and Water Bucket are supplied	

## RULES

We need a few families to bring shovels, brooms, rakes and wheelbarrows. We can share!!!! Mark your name and the club name on everything you bring to the fair—things do get carried away or left lying around and this way it is easier to locate.

**Health papers** must be hung up when animal is brought into the fair—NO exceptions!!! Place your papers in a gallon zip lock freezer bag so the papers do not get ruined. Make a copy in case something happens to your original.

\*\*\*\*\***All animals MUST be fed, watered, and cleaned by 9:00 a.m. each day.** Please check on your animal throughout the day and keep its stall/pen clean. Animal must have **water at all times!** And make sure they have enough feed to keep them content.

During **market judging** you **must wear the t-shirt provided** to you by the Junior Fair.

Also you must wear some type of pants or jeans and boots—no tennis shoes or sandals.

During **showmanship** you can wear a nice shirt—**no club shirts!!** During the **sale** you can wear any appropriate attire (club shirt, if desired) to sell your animal—be clean and neat!

Everyone must clean out their own stall/pen by the Saturday after the fair. We will have clean up Thursday, September 7 at 6:00 p.m. Market Books are due at this time. Please do not do this the last day of the fair because the haulers sometimes mess up the pens. Also we will be taking down decorations starting at 9:00 p.m. the last day of the fair—we need as much help as possible.
