Tagging day is **MANDATORY** to exhibit in the Mahoning County Junior Fair.

Market & Market Dairy Goats and Market/Carcass Lambs MUST BE BROUGHT to tagging

MARKET SWINE: For 2022, **first year Market Swine members MAY bring swine for committee to help tag and give vaccines. All others MUST pick up their tags and vaccines on May 21 at the Market Tagging.** The committee will have the tags bagged and will have them ready for pick up. Each member will be responsible for tagging their own animal. Families may purchase their own tagger, or clubs may purchase taggers to share within in your group. The tagger must be an Allflex tagger which can be easily ordered online or purchased at Witmer's Feed & Grain, Millstone, Heritage or possibly other local feed stores. To complete your tagging requirement, you will be responsible for completing the Market Swine ID form to include the **front, left side and right side photos of your animal(s), along with an head/ear photo showing the tag in the ear. We are using a NEW ONLINE Market Swine Tagging Form which can be found on the website at www.mcjrfair.com. All animals tagged MUST be photographed and forms submitted by JUNE 18 or they will be unable to exhibit in the 2022 Junior Fair Show.**

MARKET SWINE VACCINE: For 2022, **the erysipelas vaccine will be mandatory per the fair veterinarian.** If your breeder vaccinated your pigs, please bring a copy of proof of vaccination to tagging. Vaccines will be donated by Lisbon Vet Clinic. The Market Livestock Committee will have the donated vaccinations available when you pick up your tags.

MARKET/CARCASS LAMBS - IMPORTANT: We will be weighing during tagging. We ask that you know which animals you would like to designate as Market or Carcass when you come to tagging and have this marked on an index card along with each animal's scrapie ID number. A form is available on the website to complete and bring to tagging.

MARKET & MARKET DAIRY GOAT: Please mark scrapie ID on an index card and have this ready at tagging. All wethers must be banded or castrated at the time of tagging. A form is available on the website to complete and bring to tagging.

TRAFFIC FLOW:

Market Swine, Goats and Sheep exhibitors will enter GATE 9 ONLY off of Route 46. Gate 8 will be **EXIT ONLY.**

Market Swine (and members who have Swine & Lambs/Goats): Enter Gate F. Stop at pavilion to pick up tags and vaccines. First year members needing committee assistance with tagging and/or vaccines, take a left to head to Cattle Coliseum #61. Take a left by the Dairy Cattle Coliseum and be patient and slip into the goat and lamb traffic to enter the Dairy Coliseum. Listen to direction from committee. All other head straight out Gate 8.

Market Goat & Market Lamb only exhibitors will enter Gate G. Please be courteous and cautious as you enter the Coliseum. Lambs will stay left, and goats will stay right. Exit and take a left to head out Gate 8.

Arrive during the time you are scheduled.
