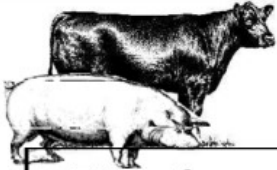
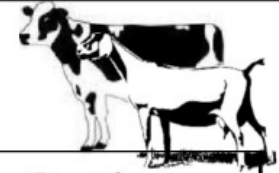

Your purchase at the Market Junior Fair Sale will provide the best beef, pork, lamb, goat, poultry and rabbit to serve at your table. The sale gives our youth the opportunity to profit from their hardwork, and successfully complete their livestock project by selling their quality product to you as a buyer.

Online sales make buying at our sale easier too! Download the Canfield Fair App, watch the Canfield Fair Website or the Mahoning County Junior Fair Website for the online auction link. Our online sale will also permit proxy bids - so think about how much you would like to bid on an animal or product, and place your bid. The program will automatically bid for you.

Easy Steps to Buying Quality Meat, Cheese & Fudge

- Visit the Canfield Fair either Thursday, Friday or Monday, or join us online.

Thursday: 5:30 p.m. - Goat Milk Fudge, Rabbits, Market Goats
7:00 p.m. - Market & Carcass Lambs & Market Swine

Friday: 4:00 p.m. - Market Chickens, Ducks, Turkeys,
7:00 p.m. - Market Beef

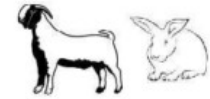
Monday: 10:00 a.m. - Dairy Cheese Sale
11:00 a.m. - Beef Feeders, Beef Heifer Feeders, Dairy Feeders



- Report to the Market Livestock/Sale Office inside the Event Center to register as a buyer, or register online.
- Take a seat in the Event Center and get ready to bid, or join us on your computer.
- Pay after you purchase. For livestock, you will choose a butcher. Animals purchased will be hauled directly to the facility. You call the butcher and tell him how to package your meat. Once packaged, they will call when your meat is ready. Dairy Cheese and Goat Milk Fudge are presented to the buyer immediately after purchased or arrangements can be made for pick up.



Affordable Ways to Buy



- You may purchase for your family or form a partnership with a neighbor or friend and split the animal
- Businesses purchase to advertise your company. Buy it for yourself or give it to your staff or a customer.
- Donate your purchase to a local pantry or organization.
