- Working at least 20 hours during the fair, and at least 15 hours pre/post fair workdays

Please note: Three unexcused absences will be reason for dismissal from the Junior Fair Board. After the second unexcused absence, the member will receive a verbal warning. Excused absences must be approved by the Senior Fair Board Director, Junior Fair Manager, or an adult supervisor. We expect youth not to abuse this privilege. (Simply stated: No phone call. \(\sigma\) Not excused.) Many youth wish to have the privilege of being a Junior Fair Board member. If you accept this appointment, please know that you will be expected to fulfill your obligations to Junior Fair Board at your best potential. The 2023 Junior Fair Board can only be successful if we all agree to work together as a team.
